ARMSTEAD THOMPSON MASON COCKERILL (1841-1870) entered the 24th Ohio Volunteer Infantry, Company "D," as a private, when twenty years of age; was promoted and finally mustered out .June 24, 1864, as Colonel of the regiment. After the war he lived at Hamilton, Ohio, and served as Assessor of Internal Revenue in the 6th Ohio District by appointment of President Johnson. Later he moved to West Union and, his health impaired by military service, he died at the early age of 28 years and is buried beside his father at West Union, Ohio, He left a son named for himself, who is a machinist, and lives at Hamilton, Ohio.
