John Crawford (son of John and Elizabeth Crawford)

(II) John (2) Crawford, son of John (1) and Elizabeth Crawford, remained in Monmouth county, where his father conveyed land to him by deed dated August 3, 1691, but not signed and delivered until March 9, 1693 (Trenton Deeds F, 739; Monmouth Deeds A, 36).

His father also gave him the Nutswamp tract which has been the Crawford homestead for many generations. He was a grand juror of Monmouth county in 1693. Not later than 1698 he married Abigail, surname unknown, who bore him at least one son, George Crawford.

1698: John Crawford, Jr., and wife Abigail, of Middletown, sold to Elisha Lawrence, of the same place, 280 acres, which he received from his father, August 3, 1691.

1704, November 25: Administration was granted on the estate of John Crawford, Jr., of Middletown.
